

2016-2017 North Junior High School's "Dress for Success"

Below is the approved dress code for North Junior High School. The dress code below lists items you can wear. School administration reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of any item. Students found to be in violation of the dress code will be asked to correct the article found to be in violation prior to returning to the classroom and could face further disciplinary action.

The following is acceptable dress for North Junior High School:

Pants

Type: uniform style or dress
Solid colors: navy, khaki, black
Worn at natural waistline

Shorts, Capris

Knee-length (top of the knee) or longer
Type: uniform style or dress
Solid colors: navy, khaki, black
Worn at natural waistline

Skirts

Knee-length (top of the knee) or longer
Type: uniform style or dress
Solid colors: navy, black, tan, brown, khaki

Collared Shirts

Type: button-down, polo-type
Long- or short-sleeved
Appropriately sized
Solid colors: any
Logo: small logo acceptable up to 3"
No more than 2 buttons undone
A solid color t-shirt (long- or short-sleeved) may be worn underneath

Cool-weather items

A solid color collared shirt must be worn underneath
Logo: small logo acceptable up to 3"
Must be hoodless
Solid colors: any
Type: cardigan, sweater, vest, or zip-up solid color fleece

Sweatshirts

Type: crewneck
Solid colors: any
Logo: North or legitimate college/university logo acceptable

Footwear

Any EXCEPT: flip-flops, athletic slides or house shoes. Must be closed toe and back shoes.

Hair Styles/Headbands

Must be natural hair colors and not cause a distraction
All headbands must be worn on top of student's head, not on forehead. We do not allow any handkerchief headbands of any color

Spirit Wear Every Friday

Uniform pants or shorts
NHS Shirts: unaltered North tee shirt or North sports team/uniform top

Body Piercing:

All body piercings except for ears are prohibited at middle school level

The following is unacceptable at North Junior High:

- Hair covering the eyes or face
- Sagging pants that reveal any undergarments or skin during normal movements
- Chains and Mardi Gras beads
- Body piercings, excluding ears. No earrings that pose a safety hazard or that are disruptive in nature
- Visible tattoos
- Hats
- Dyed hair that is not a natural color (i.e. reds, blues, yellows, greens, fuchsia)
- Student writing on clothing or body with pen/markers
- Large purses, gym bags, backpacks, backpack style purses, and drawstring bags must be kept in students' lockers
- Stretch pants or leggings
- Any contacts other than natural eye color
